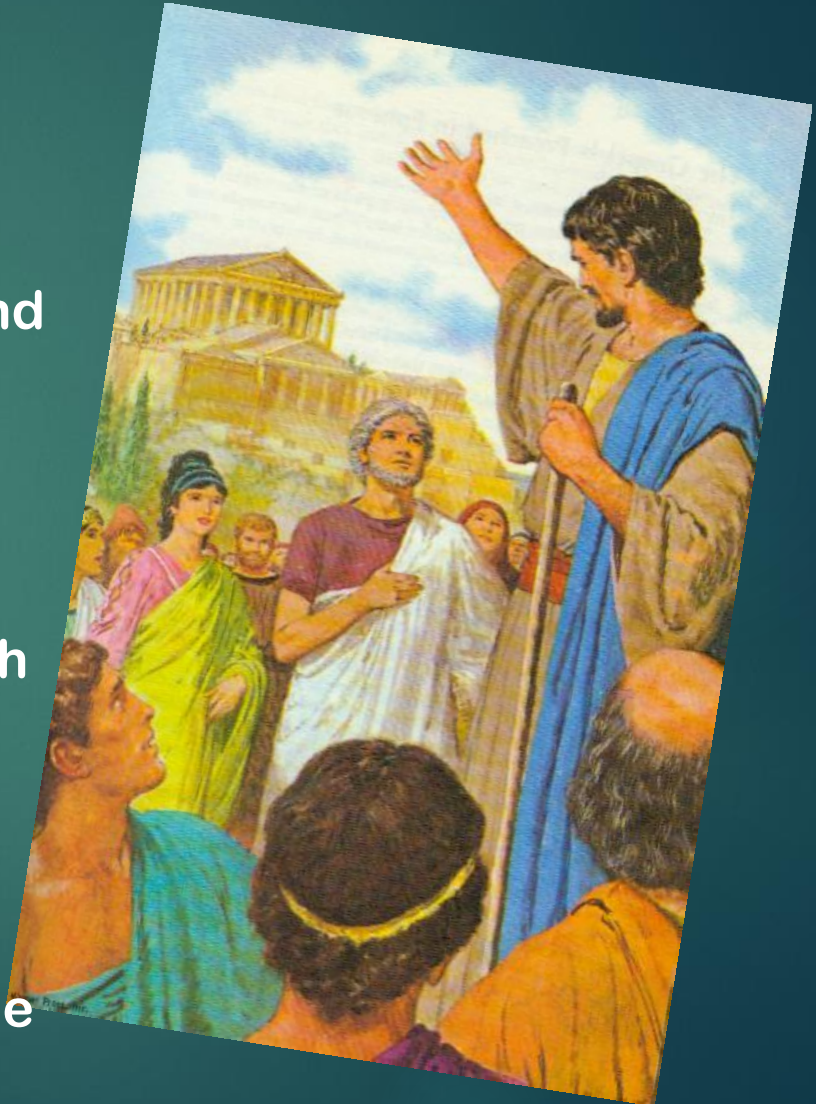
- ▶ Missionary, Evangelist and Church Planter.
